



Teachers' Responsibilities During Visits School Trips

At City Challenge, the safety and wellbeing of all students is a shared responsibility between our team and visiting schools. Our staff will actively supervise students while they are participating in scheduled activities within the venue, ensuring a safe, structured, and enjoyable experience.

Outside of scheduled activities, supervision is the responsibility of the accompanying school staff at all times.

We kindly ask that teachers and school representatives remain on-site for the full duration of the visit. While there is no requirement to accompany students at each individual attraction, staff should remain accessible and attentive throughout the session to support with group management if needed.

Students are expected to follow all venue rules and safety instructions at all times. Our team will provide clear guidance before and during activities to ensure everyone understands how to participate safely and respectfully.

In the event of repeated or serious misconduct, our team may escalate the situation to school staff for support. City Challenge reserves the right to remove any student from an activity if their behavior poses a risk to themselves, other visitors, or staff members.

If a student is removed from the activity area, they will need to remain under the supervision of school staff in a designated area outside the play zone for the remainder of the session, or until the situation has been appropriately resolved.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe, positive, and engaging environment for all participants.

As a gesture of appreciation, complimentary entry and coffee will be provided for teachers (1 per 10 students).

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
